ELECTRICIAN

- 1. Install, maintain and repair electrical control, wiring, and lighting systems
- 2. Diagnose malfunctioning systems, apparatus, and components, using test equipment and hand tools, to locate the cause of a breakdown and correct the problem.
- 3. Connect wires to circuit breakers, transformers, or other components.
- 4. Inspect electrical systems, equipment, and components to identify hazards, defects, and the need for adjustment or repair, and to ensure compliance with codes.
- 5. Advise management on whether continued operation of equipment could be hazardous.
- 6. Maintain current electrician's license or identification card to meet governmental regulations.
- 7. Plan layout and installation of electrical wiring, equipment and fixtures, based on job specifications and local codes.
- 8. Direct and train workers to install, maintain, or repair electrical wiring, equipment, and fixtures.
- 9. Prepare sketches or follow blueprints to determine the location of wiring and equipment and to ensure conformance to building and safety codes.
- 10. Install ground leads and connect power cables to equipment, such as motors etc.
- 11. Perform business management duties such as maintaining records and files, preparing reports and ordering supplies and equipment.
